

BROW LIFT?

"Her brows seem heightened and separated — both suggestive of a brow lift," says Dr. Glasberg. And her forehead looks "almost frozen. She's smiling without wrinkles. These are signs of Botox."

FACE LIFT?

"It appears she's had a facelift," says Dr. Glasberg. "She was getting jowly on the sides of her chin and had marionette lines [wrinkles at the corners of the mouth], but now these have vanished."

LID WORK?

Dr. Glasberg says he believes Lange has had both upper and lower lid work. "There's a difference in the lid lines between photos," he says, adding that now she's missing the "eye puffiness that was evident earlier."
